As you may be aware, a new study just released by the [Institute for Children, Poverty & Homelessness](#) points out that funding has remained flat. And states vary widely in their commitment to identifying and serving homeless students. Further, severe cuts to our national education budgets, calculated in excess of **\$9.2 billion** and the elimination of **\$1.2 billion** in grants for after-school and summer programs will eliminate teacher training, scale back or cripple several crucial programs that help low-income children.

I am heart-wrenched to know that the [National Center for Homeless Education](#) reported that 1.3 million students experienced homelessness during the 2014-15 school years, with a 3.5 percent increase in each of the three previous years. Like you, I am concerned about education funding and how it will impact children.
